- ▣ **Who:** The camp will be divided into two age groups:

Junior Camp is for children who have **COMPLETED** 4th through 6th Grades.

Primary Camp is for children who have **COMPLETED** Kindergarten through 3rd Grades.

- ▣ **Where:** Wheat State Camp, 11177 S.W. 87th, Augusta, Kansas 67010, (316) 775-6791 (for emergency use)

- ▣ **When:**

Junior Camp: Monday, July 26 - Thursday, July 29, 2010. Registration begins on Monday, July 26, 2010 at 11:30 a.m. Camp activities will begin at 1:00 p.m. Lunch is **not** served on Monday, July 26, 2010.

We will dismiss on Thursday, July 29, 2010 at 11:30 a.m. Lunch **is** served.

Primary Camp: Thursday, July 29 - Saturday, July 31, 2010. Registration begins on Thursday, July 29, 2010 at 11:30 a.m. Camp activities will begin at 1:00 p.m.

Lunch is **not** served on Thursday, July 29, 2010.

We will dismiss on Saturday, July 31, 2010 at 11:30 a.m. Lunch **is** served.

- ▣ **Cost:** **Junior Camp:** \$130 per camper by **June 7, 2010;** ****After June 7, 2010, \$150.****
Primary Camp: \$115 per camper by **June 7, 2010;** ****After June 7, 2010, \$135.****
If postmarked after Monday, June 7, 2010, late registrations price needs to be paid.

- ▣ **Deadline for Registration:** **June 7, 2010** (postmarked on or before **June 7, 2010**). **NO WALK-INS!** Space is limited, so get your registration in early! **After June 7, 2010, you must pay a \$20 late fee.** **Late registrations will be considered if postmarked by Monday, June 11, 2010.** However, your space is not guaranteed. Room requests will not be guaranteed. If space is not available, you will be notified by phone and your payment will be refunded.

PLEASE SEND **FULL** PAYMENT IN **ONE** CHECK PER CHURCH made payable to **Kansas District Children's Ministries.** **No refunds will be made after July 2, 2010.**

- ▣ **Camper Security:** Your child's security is of utmost importance. Upon arrival at camp, drivers will be given concise instructions for checking in and checking out children. Your full cooperation is expected.

Anyone coming to visit a child during the camp session must check in at the Camp Office in the Dining Hall immediately upon arrival. You will be given a visitors pass in exchange for your driver's license or any other valid picture ID. Unauthorized visitors will be detained by Camp Security. Before leaving the campground, you must return to the Camp Office and surrender your badge and have your ID returned.

If your child needs to leave the campground during camp, or check out early on the closing day, you **must submit a signed authorization with your Medical Form** that details who will pick up your child, their relationship to the child, reason for departure, and time of return (if applicable). Only this preauthorized person may remove your child from the campground.

In the event of an **emergency**, a child may only be removed from camp with the approval of the Camp Director in consultation with the parent/guardian or pastor listed on the camper's application.

- ▣ **Water Bottles:** We are asking each church to send water bottles for **THE CAMPERS AND WORKERS FROM YOUR CHURCH**. Water bottles can be refilled throughout each day.
- ▣ **Lice Check:** **ALL** campers are required to be checked for lice. If you have a doctor or registered nurse that knows how to do a lice check and is willing to check your kids **no more than 24 hours before the first day of their camp**, fill out the **Lice Check Form in its entirety**. This form must be presented at the time of registration. If you cannot do the lice check before you come, camp staff will provide the lice check. **Children with lice will not be allowed to stay at camp.**
- ▣ **What we do:** Devotions, chapel, Bible memory, music, swimming, crafts, sports, snacks, archery, The Blob (for 4th-6th grades only), paddle boats, and MUCH MORE.
- ▣ **Dress code:** All campers and workers are to dress modestly. **NO SHORT SHORTS, SPAGHETTI STRAPS, HALTER TOPS, OR REVEALING CLOTHING. SHOES ARE TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.** Swim shoes may be desirable. **A shirt must be worn over a two piece swimsuit. Swimwear must be covered with a shirt when camper/worker is going to or from activities as well as in all campground buildings.**
- ▣ **What to bring:** **BIBLE**, sports clothes, towels/washcloths, comb/brush, sturdy and comfortable shoes, swimsuit/beach towel/water shoes (**Swimwear must be covered with a shirt when camper/worker is going to or from activities as well as in all campground buildings**), bathroom toiletries, sleeping bags or sheets and blanket, pillow. **ALL ITEMS SHOULD BE MARKED WITH THE CHILD'S NAME!**
- ▣ **What NOT to bring:** Do **NOT** bring/send a cell phone. **MONEY — all snacks/drinks are provided, RADIO/WALKMAN, ELECTRONIC/VIDEO GAMES, FIREWORKS, WEAPONS (including pocket knives), TOBACCO, DRUGS OR ALCOHOL.**
- ▣ **Camp Rules:** All campers and workers are to follow the assigned schedule and guidelines. **Disobedience of camp rules may, at the director's discretion, result in notification of parents to come to camp and take their child home. If a child is sent home, the camp fee will not be refunded.**
- ▣ **Medication Packaging Requirements:**
 - Medications must be in their original container with dosages clearly printed on the bottle.
 - All medications must be placed in a Ziploc bag and labeled with your child's name.
 - A list of medication names should be included on the label of the Ziploc bag.
 - **Medications are to be given to the adult who is bringing your child to camp.**
 - **ALL** MEDICATIONS (both prescription and over-the-counter) **MUST** BE GIVEN TO THE CAMP NURSE UPON ARRIVAL.
 - If a child's application lists medications that are not brought to camp, it is the parents responsibility to provide them or the child will not be allowed to stay.
- ▣ **Make the most of it:** For your child to benefit the very most from his/her camp experience, make a commitment not to remove him/her from camp for any reason (baseball practice, games, or other activities).
